- 1. Pro-life responses, but she is undecided when questioned about standing up to leadership that is pro-abortion. Undecided about sponsoring pro-life legislation.
- 2. Initial anti-casino expansion response, but stated that if elected she will vote to expand casino gambling in Kentucky. Gambling expansion is a two-step process that requires a constitutional amendment. Legislators must first go on record favoring expansion. Then if it passes both Houses by a 3/5ths majority, the question goes to the ballot for citizens to either reject or ratify.
